One only need to visit our newly renovated dining hall, graciously designed and donated by this year's Leadership Greenville class, for an example of this critical level of support. The new dining hall is more than just a place to eat. It is a place for the boys to gather, to share, and to feel at home.

Generations helps boys who have lived their life experiencing unspeakable abuse and sadly, they have become abusers themselves. The boys are placed at Generations by judges instead of being placed in the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice. Generations provides a therapeutic environment where the boys, ages 10 to 18, can learn to become kids again and learn in a safe environment how to stop the cycle of sexual abuse. 98% of the boys who participate in the Generations (CARE) program go on to become productive, law-abiding members of society.
