As the calendar is turned and the boys at Generations begin a year of transformation in 2019, I would like to take a moment to reflect on the past year and the wonderful things that happened on our campuses. First and foremost, the most important statistic of all - over 100 young men received life changing services in 2018, and 35 of them successfully completed the program and returned to their communities equipped to stop the cycle of sexual abuse. The potential impact of those 35 changed lives is beyond rewarding and is the reason many of us work here.

Generations was also awarded re-accreditation by the Council on Accreditation (COA) in 2018, indicating the successful development and utilization of best practices throughout our programs, and our leadership team has been active in the recommendation of policies and the development of treatment models at the state and national levels. Our large base of volunteers and donors have also played a significant role in helping to meet the emotional needs of the residents, as well as the financial needs of the program. Our gymnasium, which is utilized year-round for recreation, family visitation, and program events, was renovated and received a new floor in 2018 thanks to the efforts of members of the community.

Generations continues to be a leader in bringing an end to the cycle of sexual abuse, but we couldn't do it without our supporters. Thank you all for your contributions to our kids' futures and for your role in changing lives in 2018.
